News from the Scottish Slopes.

Cairngorm.

All traces of the West Wall and Coire ne Ciste chair lifts have been removed. Although these chairlifts had not operated for sometime various people thought that they could have been refurbished. We will

now never know. More worryingly is the removal of snow fencing in Coire na Ciste and in the neighbouring coire. Although there is still the West wall poma, there now appears to be little interest in that side of the ski area by Natural retreats.

There may be the possibility of HIE funding a snow making factory for Cairngorm.

Glencoe.

The go ahead has been given for the new 3person chair to mbe built. It was thought that it would be ready for this season but because of problems outwith Glencoe, it will be ready for 2018-2019.

There is a 'crowdfunding' project on the go to try to raise the money to buy a snow making factory. Andy Meldrum had the technicians from Techno Alpine (the makers) visit Glencoe and from this meeting the decision was taken to buy the machine. In round figures is cost £460,000 - with the Scottish Government providing 75% of the money as a grant. Only £135000 to find by themselves. As a result of this request by Glencoe for assistance financially, the Committee decided to send £100 to help with this venture. This is the same machine as mentioned above for Cairngorm.

SCOTTISH SKIING.

Well, last season was very poor, hardly any snow. We know of one person who skis Cairngorm and he only managed 36 days skiing - about half his usual amount. Anyway - the Club still proposes to organise day/half day skiing at Glencoe at the weekend as well as during the week depending on conditions. More information as the season progresses. Just keep your fingers crossed for lots of snow.

Ski Practice nights commence in October at SnowFactor at Braehead. These nights will follow the previous season's pattern which has proved to be popular with the skiing membership.

These will be held on the last Tuesday of the month (except December).

This means we begin our nights on - Tuesday 31st October.

As in the past we start skiing at 6.30pm until about 7.30pm.

We then head to the Barvaria German Beer Stube for a meal. We don't lose slope time as we get our lift passes stamped to make sure we get the full 2hrs skiing.

After the meal we head out again and ski until about 9.30pm.

It is always possible to finish off the evening with apres ski drinks.

The club charges £18 for the ski slope time. This is subsidised by the club and does not reflect the true cost of skiing paid for by non Club members.
